Maths: Still looking at fractions, this week we have been finding fractions of amounts,

Eg. $\frac{1}{4}$ of 12 = 3 because $12 \div 4 = 3$

$\frac{2}{6}$ of 24 = 8 because $24 \div 6 = 4$, and $2 \times 4 = 8$

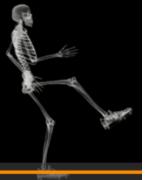
And then using this knowledge in word problems.
