**Maths:** This week, some of us have undertaken a fraction review; this has included everything we have learnt about fractions so far. Others, have been learning about decimal fractions and how to convert decimals to fractions and fractions to decimals, including measures (ml,L,km)

Eg.  $\frac{1}{10} = 0.1$  and  $\frac{1}{100} = 0.01$  so  $4.56 = 4 \frac{56}{100}$

**English:** In English we have been continuing with our diaries and have been focussing on time connectives. We have also planned and started writing our diaries as a member of Queen Boudicca's Iceni tribe.



**Science:** Finally we have finished our skeletons, stuck them into our science books and then using our newly found knowledge of bones, labelled our skeletons correctly.

As it was 'National Science Week', we had a visit from 'The Ogden Trust'. Our topic was 'hot and cold' and this involved looking at dry ice and what happened when we heated it up - (it becomes carbon dioxide gas and turns into a cloud!) as well as using a heat camera to discover things that we can't see with our naked eye, like Jack from behind the plastic bag or Bella's footprints!



**Topic:** In topic we have been comparing Greek and Roman busts. The Greeks wanted perfection, whereas the Romans wanted reality. We then used clay to model a bust of a Roman general. It was much harder than we thought it would be! We have also made a start at building a Roman shield.
