Maths: This week, we have been using and applying our knowledge of fractions to solve some reasoning questions. We have been working hard on explaining how we have found the answers.

We have also been revising addition and subtraction methods (expanded column method and column method) and had a go at solving more challenging addition and subtraction questions.

English: In English we have completed our first draft of our Celtic diaries and worked with an adult to improve them before our final draft. We have also illustrated our diaries and looked at a reading comprehension about Boudicca.

Science: This week we have started to look at how our muscles help us to do so much, like smile, run, eat, sit and drink. We have begun an investigation looking into whether people who do more sport and physical activity have stronger muscles. Our first task was to undertake as many swap jumps as we could and then record these. Next week we will look at how to collect data on how much physical activity our class undertakes during a week.
