Maths: This week we have been tackling some fluency, reasoning and problem solving questions using our multiplication skills. We have been trying to explain how we find our answers, which we have discovered can be using very different methods! We have also looked at using diagrams to solve problems.

English: This week we have been learning about how using prepositions and adjectives can make our writing more interesting, as well as planning the key points of our persuasive texts on deforestation of the rainforests.
