**Maths:** This week we have been using our addition and subtraction written methods to help us solve missing number questions.

$$34 - \square = 21 \quad \square - 45 = 134 \quad 45 + \square = 57 \quad \square + 345 = 467$$
$$34 - 21 = \square \quad 134 + 45 = \square \quad 57 - 45 = \square \quad 467 - 345 = \square$$

We have also familiarised ourselves with money and solved money problems using written subtraction and addition.

**English:** In English we have been creating a checklist of features that should be in all non-chronological reports. We then used this to assess our own work and set ourselves a target. Following this we learnt about what should be in an opening statement and looked at the more formal language used within reports. Finally we had a go at writing our own.

**Topic:** To help us with our writing we have continued researching information and facts about Rainforest animals. We then collected images that would support our non-chronological reports in English.

**Science:** This week we began our unit on sound. We had a go at a 'silent' lesson, where we had to communicate, in silence, where we thought the quietest and loudest places in school are. We then went on a sound walk to see all the different sounds we could hear from the quietest to the loudest.
