Maths: This week in maths, we have all been learning about bar graphs and pictograms. We started the week by tallying our different eye colours and created a class pictogram on the interactive board. We used this information to draw our own bar graphs. Next we recorded our favourite farm animals, completed bar graphs and answered questions about the data we collected together. Reception children have also been working on addition with dice games and activities.



English: Year 1's have been building and writing their own sentences this week based around the Julia Donaldson classic 'A Squash and a Squeeze'.

Reception children have been using their phonic knowledge to build words using picture clues, and also write short phrases independently linked to this week's class text.



Other: As we approach Remembrance Sunday, we have been learning about the significance of wearing poppies and the history surrounding this day. We visited the Clipston war memorial and decorated our own poppy wreaths and crosses.
