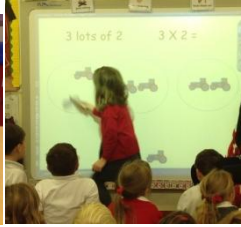
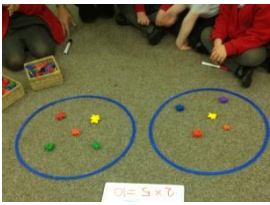


Owl Class News and Homework: w/c 14.11.16

Maths: This week in maths, we have all been learning about multiplication using groups of. We started with 2x and moved onto 3x and 4x. We used hoops to group the different amounts and then write the number sentence in our books. Reception children used paper plates and counting objects to represent the number sentences and made number lines using stampers and play dough.



English: We have been learning about recount writing this week. Using picture clues. We have been writing about trips to familiar places including the zoo, beach and circus. Year 1's have been developing their understanding of using time connectives such as first, next, then and after that.



Other: We had great fun on Tuesday planting trees and bulbs at Clipston recreational ground. We helped to dig holes, put in the saplings and secure them with canes and sleeves. Next, we planted daffodil and snowdrop bulbs in patterns.
