Maths: We have been learning about 3D and 2D shapes again with week. We discussed what makes these shapes different from each other and learnt to describe shape properties. We played a guessing game with partners to revise our knowledge of faces, vertices and edges. Finally we made 2D shapes using lolly sticks and play dough.



English: We have continued learning about letter writing this week as part of our work on The Jolly Postman book.
