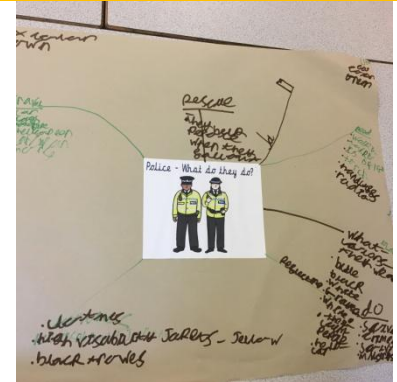


Owl Class News and Homework: w/c 20.03.17

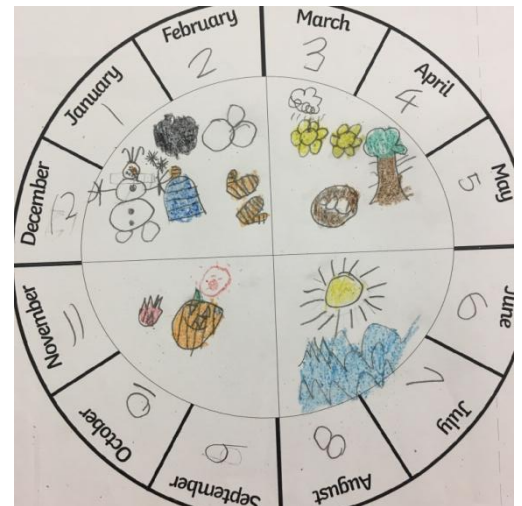
To be handed in on: 29.03.17

Maths: We have continued work on fractions this week, learning how to represent equal parts. We also have been using bar modelling to solve missing number problems and used a range of real life resources, including playing cards and coins, to solve and record simple addition.

English: This week we have been learning to write and record in different ways including lists, bullet points and mind maps. On Tuesday, we created fact posters all about policemen, we grouped the information into categories; clothing, travel and equipment. We made lists about everything we knew already then found out more from videos and pictures.



Other: In science, we have continued our work on months and seasons. In pairs we made a season wheel by numbering the different months and grouping them into spring, summer, autumn and winter and drawing pictures of what we associate with these months.
