

Owl Class News and Homework: w/c 27.02.17

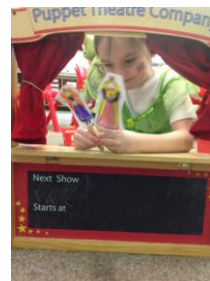
