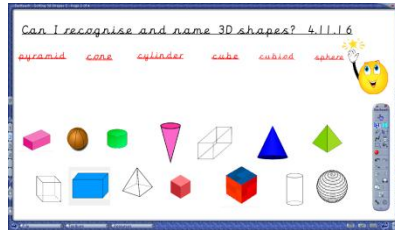


Owl Class News and Homework: w/c 31.10.16

Maths: We have all been learning about 2D and 3D shapes this week. We started the week by identifying the properties of different 2D shapes and making patterns and pictures. We then moved onto 3D shapes and learnt about faces, vertices and edges. We investigated which 3D shapes are the best for building towers and matching shapes to everyday objects.



English: We have been learning about Guy Fawkes and the history behind bonfire night. We read parts of the story in groups and sequenced the events. We wrote brilliant firework acrostic poems and also used the FANTASTICs to write bonfire senses poems.



Other: As part of our bonfire week we created tissue paper fire collages and firework work paintings. We also took part in two science experiments; 'Fireworks in a Jar' – *water, oil and food colouring reacting together* and 'Slow-Mo Fireworks' – *paper fireworks growing in water*.
