

Owl Class News and Homework: w/c 03.10.16

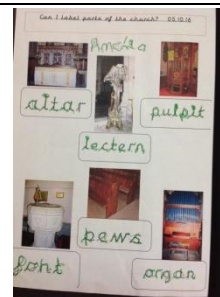

Maths: This week we have been learning about subtraction. Year 1's learnt to take away using a number line and making jumps backwards in ones, they also experimented using diene blocks, cuisenaire rods and multilink to support making number sentences and solving missing number problems. Reception children have been learning about shape and patterns. They have made repeating patterns using tissue paper and with different magnetic shapes and pegs.



English: We have been sharing a new story this week 'The Little Red Hen'. Year 1's have been familiarising themselves with time connectives and learning to write noun phrases and speech correctly. Reception children have been sequencing the story using cards and pictures and making handprint hens.

Other: As part of harvest festival, we wrote our own class prayer thanking God for all the wonderful food and crops we receive at harvest time. In RE, we visited Clipston church again, this time looking at the various parts of the church like the organ, lectern, pulpit, bells, and font. We discussed what each were used for and then wrote sentences to describe. We have also been painting autumn trees and making fruit prints.
