**Maths:** We have been focusing on doubling this week. We've been understanding the relationship between addition ( $4 + 4$ ), multiplication ( $4 \times 2$ ) and doubling, showing that we get the same answer. We've been using concrete resources, such as counting bears and dinosaurs, to show doubles and record in our books. Reception children have been using dominoes to find doubles to 10 and record number sentences in their books



**English:** We have been learning about instruction writing this week. On Wednesday, we followed simple instructions to make our own Play-Doh. Reception and Year 1's used their knowledge of lists to write the ingredients. We also learnt about using imperative (bossy) verbs, these words tell you what to do, so we had a go at using them in our own instructions.



**Other:** We have a new topic this term; People Who Help Us. We will be learning all about the people in our lives that help, from police to postmen and lifeguards to librarians. Our new role play area is a Veterinary surgery, we've had great fun taking care of all the poorly animals.



On Thursday, we had an RE day, we learnt all about the religion of Islam. We watched videos and shared pictures about Muslim mosques, learnt about the 5 pillars of Islam and made our own prayer mats.
