These are the sounds your child has been learning this week;

's' 'a' 't' 'p'

You might like to see what sounds your child can remember. If they can't make the sound, can they point to it when an adult says it or remember the picture that goes with it? You could even help your child build some words - pin, pat, tin etc.

- sssss snake (stretchy sound)
- a – a – a – apple (bouncy sound)
- t – t – t - tower
- p – p – p - pirate
