

Sparrow Class News and Homework

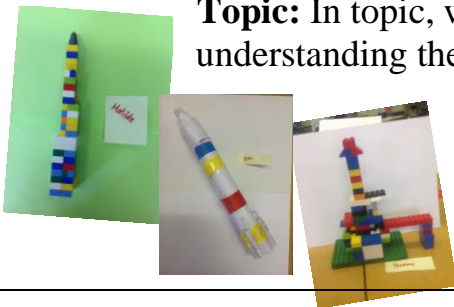
To be handed in on Wednesday 2nd December

Maths: In maths, we have been learning about doubling and halving. We revised the language needed for doubling (knowing that we are \times by 2) and used number squares and lines to help up 'see' the doubles. We practiced partitioning into 10's and 1's first, as this helped up to estimate the doubles before we worked them out. For halving, we used our previous knowledge of inverses to understand it was the opposite of $\times 2$ and knew we would be $\div 2$. We found this slightly trickier but persevered brilliantly!

English: In English, we have been continuing our newspaper writing. We plotted key events on lunar timelines to understand the chronological order of the mission and used this to help structure our reports. Together, we used shared writing time to collaborate our ideas and write part of a report together. We also conducted our mock news interview using drama to portray the people who remember this event.



Topic: In topic, we have been learning about multi-stage rockets. We started by understanding the different stages of the rockets and made our own using lego and paper to show the different parts. We investigated the spacecraft module that carries the astronauts at the top of the rocket and also learnt about Saturn V, that carried Buzz Aldrin, Neil Armstrong & Michael Collins.
