- **Information Text** - children will have opportunities to find out what life was like for their great-grandparents, grandparents and parents! They will use their new interview skills to research and compile their own information pages about growing up in the 60s, 80s and 90s!
- **Report** – Explore some of the changes in fashion and dance in the 40s, 50s and 60s. Discover more about the new ideas by watching online video clips, make notes. Write reports and contribute to a working wall display.
- **Instructions & Explanation** – Identify the features of instruction texts looking at the use of photographs and imperative verbs. Chn write instructions for a Commonwealth sport Compare features of instruction texts and explanation texts and write science explanation. How to make polish plum cake. *ICT link filming/edit/present*
- **Discussion:** Stories that raise issues: Read two picture books and one short novel on the theme of children as refugees. Compare the stories, empathise with the characters. Consider the techniques and language of story-telling. Find their own story to tell aloud then make a written version of this.
- **Narrative** Development of children's literature over the last 50 years, including non paper-based stories. Children explore the works of Dorothy Edwards, Enid Blyton and Julia Donaldson and are given the opportunity to write their own stories!
