We continued our new topic this week: Time Travelling! We made the items for the winning classroom display – designing the font to represent one past and one future date. We also gathered ideas and designed our very own time machines!

Elsewhere we continued our ‘mindfulness’ lessons, focusing on what to do in difficult situations and how we might choose to react to them.

When the Year 6s were completing their national SAT tests, we were lucky enough to teach the Owls; we made maps, used computers, made clay tiles and books - linked to the story of ‘The Jolly Postman’. Miss Glascodine said she wouldn’t have been able to do the activities without us!
