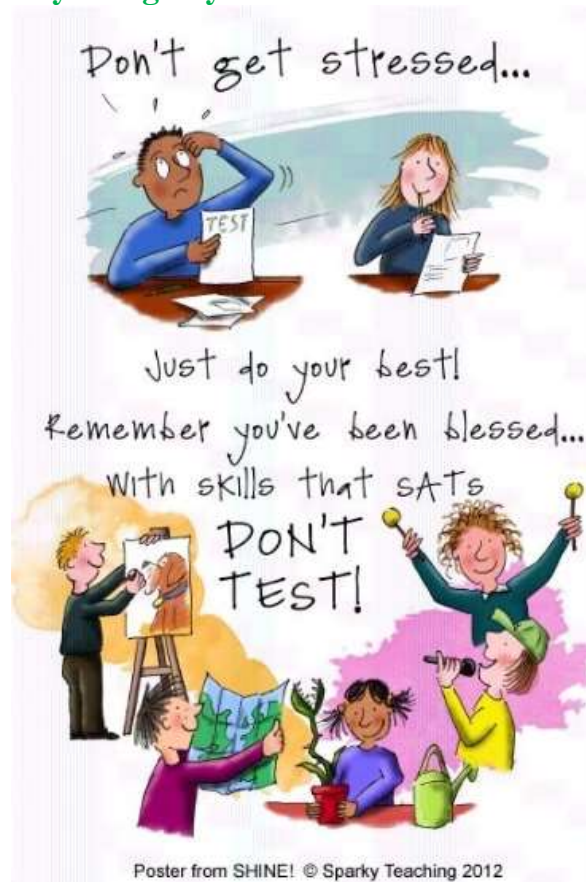
We began our new topic this week: Time Travelling! First of all we designed our classroom display – voting for which we liked the most to put up.
