Impact of the support provided by Pupil Premium funding	
As a result of the interventions provided by pupil premium funding, pupils have made good progress. With such small numbers of pupil's eligible for the funding, some of whom have other complex problems; it can be problematic to describe impact in terms of percentages without identifying individual pupils. However, all pupils have benefitted academically and socially from the support provided. For some pupils, progress has been accelerated and for all pupils well-being and self-esteem have been supported well. The Assertive Mentoring and Numicon resources have had a positive impact on the teaching and learning of Maths across the whole school.
