



Clipston Endowed VC Primary School - Annual Parent Survey 2015

There were 30 questionnaires returned out of a possible 81 (37%). Analysis: Overall 90% of all responses were either strongly agree or agree and 8% of all responses were disagree or strongly disagree. 2% or all responses were n/a or blank. The least favourable responses were about behaviour, bullying and the information provided to parents about progress. Governors are well aware of the issues surrounding inappropriate behaviour and what the school has done to address these; specific information is available from the Head Teacher. Any issue of alleged bullying brought to our attention has been reported to Governors, fully investigated and brought to a satisfactory conclusion. Feedback about progress reports (issued at the same time as the questionnaire) has been addressed at the Parent Consultations. More meaningful reports with progress using "Assessment Without Levels" will be available from the spring. Overall, the parents who took part in the survey are positive about the school.

One parent expressed concerns about the amount of time the Head is able to spend at Clipston because she is Head of two schools. Some newer parents commented on different teaching techniques between Clipston and their child's previous school and the increased level of challenge. One parent is worried about transition to secondary school. One parent expressed concerns about full time education at the age of 4 years.

The most frequent comments were about:

Mid-term reports – meaningless – preferred old report with levels – bring back old report with levels!
Concerns with way in which previous poor behaviour in a particular class was dealt with and issues around alleged bullying. Many comments were about how happy their children are, how dedicated the teachers are, how well their child is supported, how well we respond to concerns.
