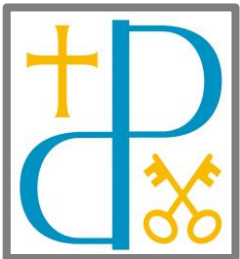

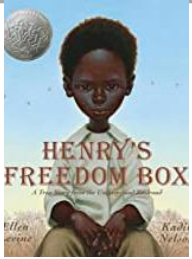

**News:** In assembly this week, Junior pupils have been listening to the American National Anthem (amazing to hear which country the children thought the anthem belonged to!) and thinking about the meaning of the words. We also discussed the outcome of the George Floyd trial before reading the book Henry's Freedom Box by Ellen Levine and Kadir Nelson, which is a true story about a slave escape on the Underground Railroad in the 1800s. The children contributed empathetic and poignant points to the discussions. In other book news, The Boy at the Back of the Class by Onjali Q Raúf is highly recommended by this Year 5 pupil. Considering the plight of a Syrian refugee, one aspect of the story involves the quest to find a pomegranate – a fruit that reminds him of home – and of course, we had to let the children see and taste a real pomegranate! It has been lovely to see our youngest pupils venture out for a walk around the village today. All the children have also been involved in the Daily Mile **Campaign** event today, discovering that walking / running ten times round the perimeter of the playground and field makes up a whole mile!
