School Staff and Governors will do their best to:-

- Care for and ensure your child's safety and happiness within a Christian community
- Achieve high standards of work and behaviour through building good relationships and developing a sense of responsibility
- Provide an enjoyable, balanced curriculum and meet the individual needs of your child
- Keep parents informed about their child's progress and any concerns or problems that affect their child's behaviour and / or work
- Set and monitor activities and work to be completed at home
- Be welcoming and available to speak with parents at a mutually agreed time
- Keep parents informed about general school matters via class letters home, newsletters, the school website, notices about special events, text messages, Twitter and emails

Parents and Carers will do their best to:-

- Ensure that my child is on time (8.50 a.m.) dressed in school uniform, with appropriate footwear
- Ensure that my child has eaten breakfast after a good night's sleep
- Provide fruit or vegetables only for break-time snacks and a healthy, well-balanced lunch or use the school hot meals service
- Contact the school about any concerns or problems that might affect my child's work or behaviour, e.g. significant change in family circumstances
- Support my child with homework and other school-related learning opportunities outside school hours
- Attend parents' evenings and discussions about my child's progress
- Ensure that children attend school unless they are ill, in which case inform the school by telephone call, by 9.15 am
- Apply for leave of absence in good time and only in extreme circumstances. Holidays are not an automatic right and this time needs to be applied for
- Respect the school's rules, policies and professional judgement of all staff
- Encourage children to lead a healthy lifestyle and apply safe practices when using social media
- Encourage your child to adopt safe practices when using social media
- Refrain from writing negative comments about the school on Facebook and other social media sites, and instead come into school to discuss things.
- Make a positive contribution to school life and the wider community
- Ensure that my child's address, medical needs and contact details are kept up to date

Pupils will do their best to:-

- Come to school prepared -
 - Whistle blown at 8.50 am.
 - With necessary equipment, e.g. book bag, PE kit
- Make a positive contribution to school life and the wider community
- Lead a healthy lifestyle: drink plenty of water and eat fruit or vegetables only at break-time
- Wear full uniform and take pride in their work and appearance
- Respect our equipment and keep the school clean and tidy
- Be truthful, honest and polite
- Try to understand other people's point of view and feelings
- Discuss problems with their work or relationships in school
- Make it as easy as possible for everyone to learn and the teacher to teach
