Year 2: Reading: Please read for 5 - 10 minutes every day, (and also use the activities outlined in your child's Read-Write-Inc. Scheme Book, if they are on this scheme).

English: This week we have been writing poetry linked to Spring.

Please write a poem about a hobby or interest you have. You can use rhyming words if you like and you might also want to write a normal poem with 2 or 3 stanzas (verses) or a Haiku which is just 3 lines. The first line is 5 syllables, the second is 7 syllables and finally the last line is 5 syllables again.

Tip: Clap it to check the syllables.

Maths Times Tables practice. Remember Times tables are 'commutative'

(i.e. 5×11 is the same as 11×5).
