

Sparrow Class' Spelling Lists: Autumn Term 1 2018

Spellings will be taught (with input on spelling rules) and given out for homework on a Friday. The children will also be required to learn a few 'tricky' exception words each week that do not follow the spelling rules taught. The following week the children will be tested on these spellings.

Week Number	Spelling Rule Words
<p>Week 1: Adding suffixes beginning with vowel letters to words of more than one syllable</p> <p>Week 2: As above, but the consonant letter is not doubled if the syllable is unstressed.</p> <p>Week 3: The /ɪ/ sound spelt y elsewhere than at the end of words</p> <p>Week 4: The 'uh' sound spelt ou</p> <p>Week 5: Prefixes. Like un-, the prefixes dis- and mis- have negative meanings</p>	<p>forgetting, forgotten, beginning, beginner, prefer, preferred</p> <p>gardening, gardener, limiting, limited, limitation</p> <p>myth, gym, Egypt, pyramid, mystery</p> <p>young, touch, double, trouble, country</p> <p>disappoint, disagree, disobey, misbehave, mislead, misspell</p>
<p>Exception words:</p> <p>Week 1: accident, accidentally</p> <p>Week 2: actual, actually</p> <p>Week 3: address, answer, appear</p> <p>Week 4: arrive, believe, bicycle</p> <p>Week 5: breath, breathe</p>
