

Sparrow Class' Spelling Lists: Autumn Term 2 2018

Spellings will be taught (with input on spelling rules) and given out for homework on a Friday. The children will also be required to learn a few 'tricky' exception words each week that do not follow the spelling rules taught. The following Friday the children will be tested on these spellings.

Week Number	Spelling Rule Words
<p><i>Week 1:</i> Prefixes. The prefix in- can mean both 'not' and 'in'/'into'. In these words it means 'not'.</p>	<p><i>inactive, incorrect</i></p>
<p><i>Week 2:</i> As above, but before a root word starting with l, in- becomes il-.</p>	<p><i>illegal, illegible</i></p>
<p><i>Week 3:</i> As above, but before a root word starting with m or p, in- becomes im-.</p>	<p><i>immature, immortal, impossible, impatient, imperfect</i></p>
<p><i>Week 4:</i> As above, but before a root word starting with r, in- becomes ir-.</p>	

Week 5: Prefixes. **re-** means
'again' or 'back'.

*irregular, irrelevant,
irresponsible*

*redo, refresh, return, reappear,
redecorate*

Exception words:

Week 1: build, busy, business, calendar, caught, centre

*Week 2: century, certain, circle, complete, consider,
continue*

Week 3: decide, describe, different

Week 4: difficult, disappear, early, eight, eighth

Week 5: earth, enough, exercise
