Harborough District County Cross-Country Championships 2020

Three of our pupils were invited to attend the the County Cross-Country Championships 2020 after successfully achieving 2nd, 14th and 15th place in their previous cross country competition held at Harborough Town Football Club. The County Championships took place at Prestwold Hall on 29th February.

It was an incredibly wet muddy day but all the same, this venue hosted approx. 500 children full of enthusiasm and good spirit ready to embrace the challenge.

We are very proud to announce that our pupils came 33rd, 67th and 88th in their races out of 90 participants per race. It is a huge achievement for our pupils to attend such an event and we are extremely proud of their success.

Daventry Schools Swimming Gala

In March, eight of our pupils set off to Daventry Leisure Centre to take part in the Daventry Schools Swimming Gala. Sixteen schools attended including us. The agenda for the afternoon comprised of three individual races: 25m Freestyle, 25m Backstroke and 25m Front Crawl kick and 4 relay races, with 3 heats per race. There were 14 races in total and all of our pupils had the opportunity to compete in a minimum of 3 races each. It was a very energetic and exhausting afternoon but all our team stayed focused on the task. They were very supportive to one another, showed great enthusiasm and determination. We were very proud of the final score of the day, gaining 10th position.

Northamptonshire Sports Virtual School Games Challenges and Competition

Northamptonshire Sports (consisting of 5 sectors of Northamptonshire) organised a Virtual Schools Games Competition which ran over a number of weeks during June and July to give pupils at school and at home the opportunity to partake in many sports activities. This was followed by a Virtual School Games Day where everyone took part in 8 Sports Skills Challenges: Athletics, Basketball, Cricket, Dodgeball, Football, Goalball, Gymnastics and Tennis. Our pupils and staff were fully engaged in these activities and the pupils were awarded with participation certificates and Spirits of Games Certificates.
