

**What to do if a member of your household tests positive**

- Please email the school immediately
- Everyone in the household must self-isolate for 10 days, even if they have no symptoms.
- If a person subsequently becomes unwell with Covid symptoms (temperature, cough, change in taste or smell) during the original 10 day period, they should get tested and then begin a new 10 day isolation if they test positive, with the rest of the household.
- Please keep us informed at school as we need to complete a daily return to the Education Department.
