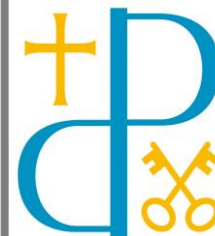

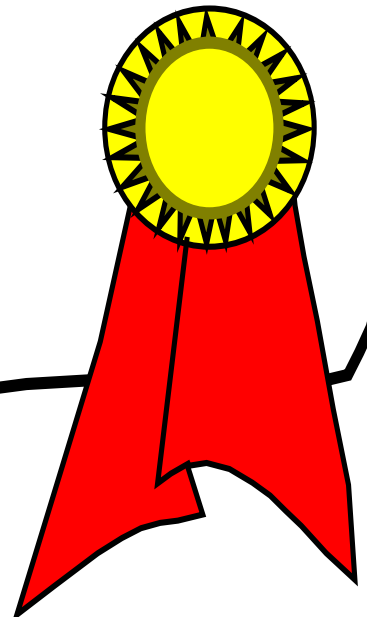

The **TREK TO TOKYO SUMMER ACTIVITY CHALLENGE** will see schools take on the challenge to complete a journey to the Tokyo Olympics Games over the summer terms.
