

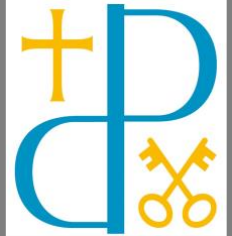

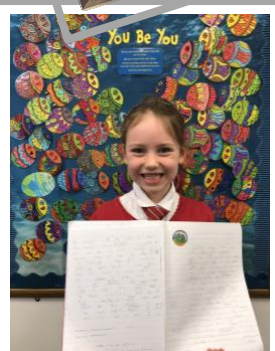

News: This week, as Hallowe'en falls during half-term, we brought forward our discussions about its origin. The children have been learning about All Saints' Day (1st November) and that "Hallow" is an old word meaning "Saint" and "Eve" means "the night before" – thus "Hallowe'en" means "The night before All Saints' Day" - which is 31st October. All Saints' Day is particularly important to Clipston, as it is the name of the village church. Children in the infant bubble also enjoyed the book "Pumpkin Soup" – a story about being kind and sharing. Children in Year 2 have been supporting the learning of children in Reception as they develop their subitizing skills – the ability to "know quickly, how many objects there are without counting" – just like we all do when using dice. At the end of last week, we had even more super writing from the children in Year 2, who are all becoming much more confident in their ability to write fluently, organise their ideas coherently and produce a good quantity of writing, too. Well done Robin Class! Thank you to everyone for their support, during this week of significant staff shortages and a huge number of pupil absences and Covid infection rates. We hope that half-term will enable us all to recalibrate and that next term brings some relief to the seemingly never-ending disruptions to the children's learning.
