

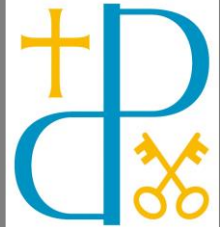

News: In assembly this week, we marked National Holocaust Remembrance Day with a focus on Mrs Mercer’s signed copy of Lily Ebert’s book and referencing other books about the Holocaust including Hana’s Suitcase and Anne Frank’s diary. The children were interested to hear that Lily, a Jewish Holocaust survivor, who received an MBE from HM King Charles III this week, made it her mission to “tell the world” of her experiences during WWII. Children articulated poignant, insightful comments about this sensitive topic and made links to our school Bible Quote “Do unto others as you would have them do unto you” (Luke 6:31). All the children thoroughly enjoyed Enrichment Day, which combined Relationships Workshops for Years 4 to Year 6, First Aid Sessions for all year groups and the creation of Gaudi inspired Spires and Chimneys as part of the Art and Design Unit on Architects. Many thanks to the School Association for funding the Gaudi resources. And finally, local Magistrates were hugely complimentary about the engagement and excellent manners of Year 5&6 during their visit to support the children’s learning about British Values and The Rule of Law.
