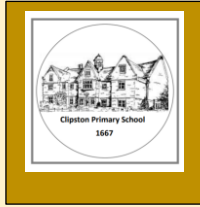
Sponsored Walk

Let's Walk 100 Miles Together

Many of you will know that last year, a pupil at Clipston lost their father to an exceptionally rare disease called CJD.

Aden has expressed a wish to raise some money for the CJD charity that has supported his family. With the help from staff at Clipston and the support of the school community, we are going to make this happen.

The whole school will be taking part in a "Sponsored Walk" from the school to Haddon Fields and back after lunch on **Monday 15th May**.

The distance will be just under a mile in total, so with all of us taking part, we will collectively walk about 100 miles.

With a suggested **minimum sponsorship of £1**, Aden hopes to raise £100 for the CJD Support Network. Donations of any amount, however small, really will make a huge difference to the vital work this charity does in supporting the families who need them. If you are unable to donate, then simply the taking part will show support for Aden and his family, as the first anniversary of his dad's death approaches.

Please ensure that your child comes to school with a coat on Monday 15th May and a sun hat, just in case the weather be more summery by then!
